RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1) Cavies will be judged in accordance with the standards and general Show Regulations as provided by the ANCC (Australian National Cavy Council).
- 2) Cavies must be registered with the state registrar at close of entries time.
- 3) No immediate family of the Judge or member of the Judge's household, or persons or people in partnership with the Judge, may show cavies at this Show
- 4) Entries for breed classes should be received by the advertised date on the form provided.
- 5) No late entries will be accepted.
- 6) The Steward will call for each class twice; if an exhibitor fails to place the cavy on the table the exhibit will be scratched.
- 7) The Steward is in charge of running the breed's class table. Unless instructed, no one is to go behind the judging table while judging is in progress.
- 8) The Judge's decision is final. No Discussion or correspondence will be entered into.
- 9) No speaking at the Judging Table whilst judging is in progress unless the Judge or Steward speaks to you.
- 10) The Judge may order any person or Cavy from the competition for bad conduct of one or both.
- 11) The Judge can disqualify any cavy which he/she thinks is unfit for showing.
- 12) Only one handler permitted for each cavy on the judging table.
- 13) No substitute animals will be permitted.
- 14) Ill or mite infested Cavies will be removed from the Premises.
- 15) No straw or hay to be taken into the premises. Wood shavings are allowed, however, any mess must be cleaned up by the exhibitors.
- 16) Smoking is not permitted on the premises.
- 17) Cavies purchased from a Judge, cannot be exhibited under that Judge, until the expiration of 6 months, from the date of purchase.
- 18) All cavies apart from longhairs must be shown on carpet squares.
- 19) Longhair cavies should be shown on a round or square board.
- 20) Scratchings must be advised by 8.30am on the day of showing.
- 21) Cages with open viewing area permitting a display for the public only to be used.

22) The Show Society will be most anxious for the care and safety of cavies sent for exhibition or any other property entrusted to it, but it must be clearly understood by exhibitors and all other persons, that the Show society will not be responsible for the loss, detention of or damage to any cavy or other property whether arising from accident or other cause whatsoever or from any act or omission of itself, its officers, agents, servants and others. Unless authorised by the Show Society, no cavy or other animal will be permitted to enter the building other than those entered for exhibition.

23) Only Cavies entered in the “Sale Class” of this Schedule may be sold or offered for sale to the public at the Royal Launceston Show.
