**BOVINE JOHNS REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO THE EXHIBITION OF DAIRY
CATTLE AT THE 2010 ROYAL LAUNCESTON SHOW**

- (1) Cattle from MN1 herds to be penned separately to cattle from untested herds.
- (2) Cattle washes and unloading areas are sign posted for MN1 herds and untested herds.
- (3) All dairy cattle to stay in their designated area.

TYPE AND UTILITY CLASS (CLASS 243) – as a basis of qualification cows competing in this class must have produced:-

2 years old – 135kg B/Ft.
3 years old – 160kg B/Ft.
4 years old – 180kg B/Ft.
Mature cows – 200kg B/Ft.

Judging will be on the type basis only, no further points will be allotted for production.

- (b) Exhibitor of Champion Guernsey Cow will receive a Dr RM KINROSS MEMORIAL TROPHY provided her dam has produced under an official lactation testing scheme at least 50kg butterfat in excess of her age standard.

In the event of the above conditions not being complied with the prize valued at \$18.90 will not be awarded. An animal is entitled to win the award once only at the Royal Launceston Show.
