

## **2010 JUNIOR BEEF CATTLE HANDLING CLASSES**

**JUDGING TO COMMENCE AT 8.30 A.M. ON SATURDAY 9<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER  
PLEASE COMPLETE AND RETURN ENCLOSED ENTRY FORM BY  
FRIDAY 24<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 2010**

Entry Fee: \$7.50 provided the animal being paraded is entered in the open competition of the relevant breed society.

\$15.00 if the animal is not entered in the breed section.

Late entries will incur a penalty of \$7.50 and no late entries will be accepted after 5.00pm on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> October, 2010.

Entry Fee entitles the participant to entry to the showground on Friday and Saturday - tickets will be forwarded by post.

Class to be arranged on age of participants as at 31.12.2010.

9-12 years, 13-14 years, 15 - under 17 years, 17 - under 20 years

20 - under 25 years (Junior bulls ONLY to be used for this age group)

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prizes - A trophy donated by Page Transport Pty Ltd and Society's sash.

### **POINTS TO BE AWARDED FOR:**

- a) Grooming technique and presentation of animal.
- b) Personal grooming and attire of the handler.
- c) Approach to animal.
- d) Knowledge about heifer.
- e) Ability of handler to lead and present the animal.

### **NOVICE HANDLER - ALL AGE GROUPS**

Novice handler has never been placed at a show either beef or dairy, (this does not include the heats). Novice handler to wear a coloured ribbon on left arm and will be judged during the general classes.

A trophy donated by Page Transport Pty Ltd and Society's sash. Will be presented at the end of judging.

### **JUNIOR HANDLERS' SCHOOL TEAM**

Three handlers to represent their school irrespective of breed of cattle and age of handler.

Please note: Students must participate in Junior Beef Handler classes to be eligible to compete in this event.

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Society Sash.

Note: Champion Handler Age Group and Grand Champion Junior Beef Handler to be judged whilst the School Teams remain on the parade ground.

### **JUNIOR CHAMPION**

To be selected from the first place getters of 9 to under 17 age groups (excluding Novice).  
Prize: Society Sash and Trophy donated by Page Transport Pty Ltd.

### **SENIOR CHAMPION**

To be selected from the first place getters of the 17 to under 25 age groups (excluding Novice).

Prize: Society Sash and Trophy donated by Page Transport Pty Ltd.

### **GRAND CHAMPION**

Will be selected from Junior and Senior Champions.

Prize: Society's Champion Sash and Leather Halter donated by Page Transport Pty Ltd.

### **NOTES TO JUNIOR CATTLE HANDLERS:**

1. The committee reserves the right to amend classes depending on entrants received.
  2. Nose Clips must be worn whenever the animal is being moved (i.e. loading on and off the truck, walking to the wash area, the show ring etc).
  3. For the safety of participants protective footwear and clothing is to be worn (i.e. gumboots, boots (not sandals) and wet and dry weather clothes).
  4. Cattle to be on the show grounds by 6.00pm Friday evening.
  5. Insurance and Public Liability is the responsibility of the owner/exhibitor.
  6. Individual entrants to register between 4.00pm and 5.00pm on Friday afternoon and entrants' responsibility to collect and return bibs.
  7. All handlers are to make themselves aware of all hygiene procedures in relation to Johnes disease and the status of animals.
  8. All handlers who are staying on the grounds overnight must sign the register at the Beef Cattle Committee Office before 4pm each day. Junior Handlers must be signed in by an adult.
