CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

This Show is conducted under Royal National Agricultural and Pastoral Society rules and conditions and where necessary Equestrian Australia & Show Horse Council of Australasia Rules. THE RNAPS ASKS COMPETITORS TO ASSIST IN MAKING SURE THAT ALL AREAS OF SAFETY ARE COVERED. YOUR CO-OPERATION IN THIS AREA WOULD BE GREATLY APPRECIATED.

- Entries will be accepted at the discretion of the society and no correspondence will be entered into regarding acceptances.
- The Society reserves the right to alter the program if necessary.
- Classes lacking numbers maybe combined
- Please make sure you comply with the rules of the classes you are entering.
- Owners entering their horses do so entirely at their own risk, and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the Society, its Council Officers, Officials or Members in any respect whatsoever, other than the liability for refund of entry fee in the event of abandonment of any competition.

REGISTRATIONS

Saddle Horses: All Hacks, Galloways and Ponies (unless otherwise stated) entered in any class **MUST** be registered with the Equestrian Australia or the Show Horse Council of Australasia National Saddle Horse Register. **Registrations pending will not be accepted.**

Riders: All riders **MUST** be a current financial member of the Equestrian Australia or the Show Horse Council. **Memberships pending will not be accepted.**

Height Certificates: All exhibitors of saddle horses **MUST** carry a **CURRENT EA or SHC** issued height certificate, relevant to the registration and class in which they are entered.

Height Certificates to be presented on request to the Chief Steward at the Arena Office.

Helmets: All riders must wear approved head gear at all times whilst riding.

Scratchings: All scratchings prior to the show must be in writing and accompanied by a Veterinarian or Doctor's certificate. If scratching during the show PLEASE inform the arena office.

Payment of Prize Money: To be posted to winners within 14 days of completion of show. Prize money may be substituted by product.

Code on Drugs and Cruelty to an Exhibit: It is the intention of the Society that all animals shall perform on their merits without the aid of drugs, which may affect their conduct, performance or appearance. **Random swabbing will take place.** Cruelty to animals is forbidden either in the arena, exercise area or elsewhere. Any person found guilty of an offence will be reported to other Royal Show Societies, the Equestrian Australia and the Show Horse Council of Australasia.

Stabling: Straw will be provided by the Society for initial bedding only. Horse boxes must not be locked while occupied by an exhibit. They may be locked while the exhibit is out competing. Please make sure your stable is kept clean and the alleyways are clear at all time for the public. HORSES ARE NOT TO BE PREPARED IN THE ALLEYWAY. ALL PREPARATION IS TO TAKE PLACE IN THE BOXES. This has been identified as a risk management issue as the stable complex is open to the public at all times. Horse boxes will be allotted subject to the Society's right to accept or reject any application and to cancel or re arrange allotment of any box as may be necessary. **ALL manure to be picked up.**

All boxes **MUST** be cleaned after use.

SMOKING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN THE STABLE COMPLEX AT ALL TIMES.

Class Definitions:

Novice Horse and Novice Rider Classes: Horses not to have won as a ridden horse or pony at a Royal show at the time of judging. Riders not to have won at a Royal Show at the time of judging. The winners of the Novice Small Pony, Large Pony, Galloway and Hack are eligible for the BEST NOVICE SADDLE EXHIBIT.

Novice Show Hunters: Horses not to have won as a ridden horse or pony at a Royal show at the time of judging. The winners of the Novice Show Hunter Pony, Show Hunter Galloway and Show Hunter Hack are eligible for the BEST NOVICE SHOW HUNTER SADDLE EXHIBIT.

Age of Riders: As per the day of competition.

Smartest on Parade: These classes will not have an individual workout.

Owner Rider Classes: Rider to be a registered owner of horse

Good Hands: Competitors judged solely on riding ability with special attention paid to the hands and seat, and the general management and control of the mount.

Competitors must use an ordinary snaffle. Cavesson nosebands permitted only. Riders may not wear gloves or carry a whip or hacking cane.

Leading Rein: For competitors not competing in any other classes. The three classes are judged concurrently. Pony to be shown in a snaffle bridle, with the leather lead attached to the noseband. No aids shall be used to keep the pony's head in position. No whips or spurs permitted. Riders should be able to rise to the trot. Handler may carry a cane. Pony 12.2 hands and under, Rider 5 years and under 9 years on the day of the show.

CHAMPIONS: Champions will be selected from the first prize winners and Reserve Champions from the remaining first prize winners and the second prize winners in the class(es) that supplied the Champion.

The Champions from the Small Pony, Large Pony, Galloway and Hack classes are eligible for the "**JIM HUGHES AND SON SUPREME CHAMPION RIDDEN EXHIBIT**".

The Champions from Show Hunter Small / Large Pony, Show Hunter Galloway and Show Hunter Hack are eligible for the Supreme Show Hunter Exhibit, which is awarded the "**MERRIMAN SUPREME CHAMPION HUNTER EXHIBIT**".

All Champions must start in these classes or notify the Arena Office. In the event of a Champion not starting in this class, the Reserve is eligible to represent that section and compete for applicable Supreme Champion Exhibit.

LUNGE FACILITIES: exhibitors are able to lunge on Southern end /Aurora Stadium end of arena ONLY prior to competitions commencing.

EXHIBITORS: Please note that all manure and rubbish is to be removed from parking, stable and working areas. Scoopers and rubbish bins provided. Our future use of this space depends on your co-operation.
