CLOSING DATE: 17th SEPTEMBER 2010

INFORMATION: Condition of entry

1. Class 1, 2, 3 Pony Club/School events.
2. One horse one rider will apply for Pony Club/School events.
3. Combinations MUST enter two events ie Class 1(a) and 2 or Class 1(b) and 3.
4. Dress Pony Club or School attire.
5. PCAT approved safety helmet.
6. **Enter pony club/school combination in pre-selected order.** (Numbers of entries may need to be reduced) this will be advised after receipt of entries.
7. Please make sure you have booked and paid for a stable ie through pony club or school entry.
8. Riders are requested to prepare horses in stable not in allyway as the stable area is open to the public.

ENTRY FEE: **\$15 per combination for Pony Club** (DC to approve entry)
 \$15 per combination for School (School to approve entry)
 (Riders will be issued with a gate pass)

STABLING (compulsory): \$10 per horse per day

Pony Club and School Team Event - All riders in team - best scores count towards team trophy. One winning team announced for Pony Club and only one winning team announced for Schools

SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

RULES & CONDITIONS - Conducted under Equestrian Australia rules and any special rules of RNAPS.

R.N.A.P.S. ASKS THAT YOU, THE COMPETITOR, ASSIST IN MAKING SURE THAT ALL AREAS OF SAFETY ARE COVERED. YOUR CO-OPERATION IN THIS AREA WOULD BE MUCH APPRECIATED.

1. Entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Society.
2. The Society reserves the right to alter the program if necessary.
3. Please make sure you comply with the rules of the class you are entering.
4. Owners entering their horses do so entirely at their own risk, and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the Society, its Council Officers, Officials or Members in any respect whatsoever, other than the liability for refund of entry fee in the event of abandonment of any competition.
5. Riders are requested to prepare horses in stable not in allyway as this area is open to public.

REQUIREMENTS FOR OFFICIAL CLASSES:

Graded Classes: Rider Member of EA and horses registered and hold grading card.

Non-Graded Classes: Rider Member of EA

Junior Classes: Rider Member of EA

JUNIORS (For Royal Launceston Show) – (Junior from the beginning of the year they turn 12 to the end of the year they turn 18)

UNDER 21 – from the beginning of the year they turn 12 to the end of the year turn 21)

ORDER OF COMPETING WILL BE DRAWN IN THE CATALOGUE.

GRADE EVENTS - Horses that have been graded will not be allowed to compete in any other grade event apart from the grade in which it belongs. If owners choose to upgrade their horses they must apply to the Equestrian Tasmania and from then on must remain there. (As per Equestrian Australian National Jumping Rules 1/7/09)

DRESS RULE

DRESS – Formal Dress as per EA National Jumping Rule 1/7/09 (256.1.5.1)

HEADGEAR - As per EA National Jumping Rules 1/7/09

Any rider entering the ring with incorrect equipment or dress is liable to be disqualified from the class.

COMPETITORS ARE REQUIRED TO KNOW THEIR “CODE OF CONDUCT”, “JUMPING RULES” and ‘PRACTICE ARENA GUIDELINES”

CURRENT GRADING CARDS MUST BE CARRIED AT ALL TIMES AND PRESENTED TO JUDGE FOR WINS AND PLACINGS: Grading Points 1st 4 points, 2nd 2 points, 3rd 1point

Competition in Two Phases -

1. This competition comprises two phases run without interruption, each at an identical or different speed. the finishing line for the first phase being identical with the starting line for the second phase.
2. The first phase is a course of 8 or 9 obstacles with or without combinations. The second phase takes place over 4 to 6 obstacles, which may include one combination.
3. Competitors penalised in the first phase are halted by ringing the bell after they have jumped the last obstacle or when the time allowed for the first phase has been exceeded, after crossing the finishing line of the first phase. They must stop after crossing the first finishing line.
4. Competitors not penalised in the first phase continue the course, which finishes, after crossing the second finishing line
